How To Prepare For The Service



EXTERIOR OF THE HOME

- ▶ Move all planters, patio furniture that is in the proximity of the nest.
(Please be sure to exercise safety first and do not attempt to move very large furniture)
- ▶ NEVER seal the entry points of where wasps have been seen going into the brickwork

After The Treatment

- ▶ **DO NOT** use other pest control chemicals (powders or sprays) or cleaning products anywhere near spray treatment, as this will decrease or eliminate their effectiveness.

Reminder

It is not necessary for you or your pets to leave your home before, during or after the treatment.

What You Can Expect From The Treatment

Your Technician will be injecting a pesticide directly in the nest (nests located in voids that are out of reach can be controlled by placing treatment at the point of entry) to kill all stages of the insect present in the nest.

All treatments will be made with your safety in mind to ensure your health.

All persons and pets are to be kept away while the Technician is treating the area.
