

# Carpenter Ant Treatment

## CLIENT PREPARATION FORM

In order for our company to provide the most effective service possible, we ask that before our arrival you review and complete all the necessary preparations listed below. The following steps will ensure that your Technician is able to provide an effective and safe treatment.



### How To Prepare For The Service



#### KITCHEN

In areas where carpenter ants are seen and in particular the kitchen, empty bottom cupboards and bottom of closets.



#### EXTERIOR OF THE HOME

Move all planters, patio furniture, etc. 12" (30 cm) away from the outside walls (Please be sure to exercise safety first and do not attempt to move very large furniture).



#### LIVING ROOM, BEDROOMS, GARAGE, ETC

Move all furniture 12" (30 cm) away from the walls (Be sure to exercise safety first and do not attempt to move large furniture.) Clear all closet floors and shelves of shoes and other items. Clothing on hangers may be left in place.

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## After The Treatment

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The bait and spray treatment will remain effective only if the following steps are taken after your home is serviced:

▶ **DO NOT** use other pest control chemicals (powders or sprays) or cleaning products anywhere near bait

placements or spray treatments, as this will decrease effectiveness.

▶ Remove all competing food sources (this means keeping all foods in tightly sealed containers, cleaning up spills as they occur, removing trash on a regular

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## Reminder

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**It is necessary for you and your pets to leave your home for 4 hours once the treatment begins.**

Fish aquariums maybe left onsite, however they should be covered and air filters must be disconnected.

Persons with underlying health conditions should consult their family physician where they have concerns regarding re-entry time. Upon re-entry, please open windows for 20 min to properly ventilate the treated rooms.

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## What You Can Expect From The Treatment

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A complete interior and exterior inspection will take place to locate any nests. Your Technician will use a variety of methods to control the carpenter ants depending on each unique situation. Sometimes it is necessary for the technician to drill small pilot holes into walls to access a carpenter ant nest.

Liquid sprays, dust and/or bait stations may be used. Bait stations should never be moved or tampered with. You will be contacted for your next scheduled inspection and treatment. All treatments will be made with your safety in mind to ensure your health.
