How to Prepare for the Service



EXTERIOR OF THE HOME (Fall):

- ▶ Move all planters, patio furniture, etc 12" (30 cm) away from the walls.
- ▶ Remove any furniture or items off the lawn areas that are close to the nest.

After the Treatment

The treatment will remain effective only if the following steps are taken after your home is serviced:

- ▶ **DO NOT** use other pest control chemicals (powders or sprays) or cleaning products anywhere near bait placements or spray, as this will decrease or eliminate their effectiveness.

Reminder

- ▶ Due to this being an outdoor treatment. Keep pets and children off the lawn and away from the nesting area where the treatment has been applied.

What You Can Expect from the Treatment

- ▶ Your technician will use a number of methods to control the pest depending on each unique situation. Please do not move or tamper with any traps, monitors or products applied by your technician.
- These have all been strategically positioned to maximize their effectiveness. All treatments are made with your safety in mind to ensure your health.
